l. Enhancing Research Awareness and Promoting Faculty Development:

- ➤ To raise faculty understanding of research, the institution will host talks with distinguished researchers and hold national and international conferences, seminars, symposia, faculty development programs, and workshops on research methodology, intellectual property rights, and patenting.
- ➤ In order to encourage faculty members to seek doctorate and post-doctoral positions at reputable national and international institutions and organizations that have been officially recognized by UGC or AICTE, the institution must create a favorable atmosphere.
- > The university will support faculty members who want to do research in areas of interest across a range of disciplines, using funding from national and international organizations.
- > The organization will use teamwork and high-caliber research to expand knowledge and guarantee its application in real-world situations.
- > The school must offer a stimulating environment that fosters creativity and fosters higher education and research among staff and students, together with sufficient facilities and resources.
- > The institution will create Incubation Centers to support new ideas and businesses, as well as Canters of Excellence in priority sectors.
- Research initiatives based in academia and industry will be mentored by the institution.
- Research projects from the institution will be published in esteemed journals.
- ➤ The institution shall produce products and register intellectual property.

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2. Financial Assistance for Faculty Development:

In addition to covering the cost of membership dues in national and international professional associations (supported by government-accredited organizations), the institution will reimburse faculty members for expenses to conferences, workshops, and seminars. At most, INR 5,000 will be given annually in support.

- ❖ Before the academic session begins, the Cell will make sure that the institution's finances are allocated properly.
- The Cell will monitor how the fund is being used and make that faculty members are providing the appropriate paperwork and supporting materials (certificates, invoices, etc.)
- The Cell's mission is to improve industry-academia cooperation while concentrating on innovation promotion. fostering entrepreneurship and improving skill development.

3. Plagiarism Prevention:

- The institution will implement stringent policies to stop plagiarism in research projects.
- ❖ Before publishing or presenting their research, faculty members must submit it to a plagiarism detection (Turnitin).
- The college will teach instructors and students correct citation practices and plagiarism prevention strategies through workshops and training.

4. Implementation and Monitoring:

- It will be the responsibility of the Research and Promotion Cell to oversee and carry out the several policies mentioned in the paper.
- These policies will be reviewed and evaluated on a regular basis to make sure they are still effective and to make any required revisions.
