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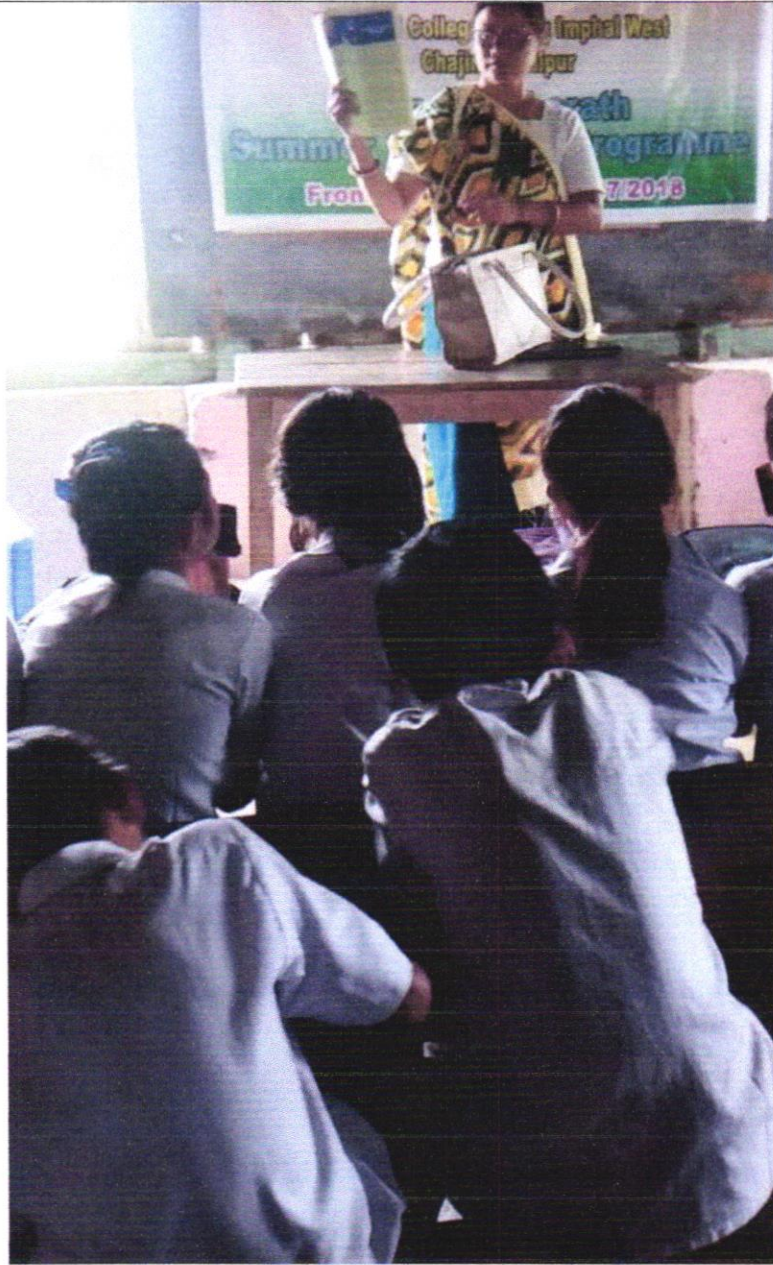
**Action Taken Report (ATR) on cleanliness drive**

<b>College Name:</b> Regional College Lilong, Imphal West Manipur	
<b>Event Overview:</b> On 20 <sup>th</sup> August 2018, the Department of Manipuri, Regional College organized an Awareness Program on Swachh Bharat at Lilong Boys Junior School, led by M. Basanti Singha, Assistant Professor in the Department of Manipuri. The event featured educational sessions, practical demonstrations and a community cleaning drive, emphasizing the importance of cleanliness, sanitation, and hygiene. The program successfully raised awareness, instilled a sense of responsibility, and provided participants with practical knowledge and tools to maintain a clean environment. Positive feedback highlighted the program's engaging approach, with future initiative plans to expand its reach and impact.

<b>Event Date</b>	20 <sup>th</sup> August 2018
<b>Event Description</b>	On 20 <sup>th</sup> August 2018, the Department of Manipuri Regional College organized an Awareness Program on Swachh Bharat at Lilong Boys Junior School in Lilong Chajing Awang Leikai. The event was led by M. Basanti Singha, an Assistant Professor in the Department of Manipuri at Regional College Lilong. The program aimed to promote the Swachh Bharat mission, emphasizing cleanliness, sanitation, and hygiene among the students and the local community.
<b>Total Days of Event</b>	One (1)
<b>Location</b>	Lilong Boys Junior School in Lilong Chajing Awang Leikai
<b>Plan of action</b>	The plan for the event included a series of educational activities and practical demonstrations to instill the importance of cleanliness. The day began with a formal inauguration and an introductory speech by M. Basanti Singha, highlighting the objectives of the Swachh Bharat mission. This was followed by interactive sessions, cleanliness drives, and demonstrations on proper waste management practices.
