About the policy:

In view of this, the College has proposed several policies so as to promote a holistic development of the differently-abled students in order to make them contribute their best to the development of their self, community, society and the nation at large.

Objective: To provide fair access to education by ensuring practical support to enable everyone to participate fully in all activities of the college.


Policies:

1. To encourage admission of differently-abled students by giving Free college admission.
2. To adhere to the guidelines of conducting written examination for person with Benchmark Disabilities.
3. To construct ramp for disabled friendly persons.
4. To ensure easy access to classrooms and laboratories at ground floor.
5. To provide wheelchairs facilities.
6. To encourage participation in the co-curricular and extra-curricular activities.
7. To give counselling and guidance to differently-abled individuals.
8. To develop appropriate teaching-learning approach according to the special needs of the differently-abled.
9. To build a disabled friendly washroom.
10. To put up wayfinding signage throughout the campus.

This policy will be reviewed periodically based on UGC guidelines for person with disabilities to rectify irregularities through impact analysis and focus group discussion. It will be circulated to the students and employees and also made available on the institutional website.
