- 11. OBJECTIVES OF THE PROJECT: The main objective of the work is to examine the socio-cultural significance of the Gaa- ngai festival. It traces the origin, migration, settlement of the people. It also looks into the origin of the Gaan-ngai festival, the significance of rites and rituals, dress and ornaments, dances, shouting of hai, songs, musical instruments, the customary

practices like promotion from one stage to another, admission new members in the dormitory etc., games and sports and social function of the festival.

- 12. WHETHER OBJECTIVES WERE ACHIEVED: The objectives of the work are achieved. The work mainly focuses on the socio-cultural significance of Gaan-ngai festival of the Rongmei people living in the state of Manipur. The Rongmei people still follow the traditions of their forefathers which handed down from one generation to the next; as they celebrate the Gaan-ngai with festive spirit and prayer. The significance of rites and rituals, dance, musical instruments, shouting of hoi, customary practices, traditional games and sports of the festival have been minutely examined; as it not only sustains the religion and culture of the people, but also promotes social cohesion.
- 13. ACHIEVEMENTS FROM THE PROJECT: The research project has systematically examined the socio-cultural significance of *Gaan-ngai* festival of the Rongmei people of Manipur. All the processes of the festival which are preserved in oral tradition have been documented; it also provides to some certain extent for future study of the tribal festivals of Manipur particularly the Rongmei festivals.
- 14. SUMMARY OF THE FINDINGS: The Rongmei of Manipur have many festivals which are ancient and have survived the stress and strain of time and circumstances. No one can say with certainty, when these festivals started, as they have no script of their own to record. Their history is preserved through the ages in form of festivals, hymns, folk dance, folk songs and folk tales. The ways of life of the Rongmei is reflected in their various festivals and their social relevance is very great. They provide not only entertainment and social festivities to them, but also act as an integrating force for the community as a whole. In a year, they celebrate about ten festivals based on agricultural operations according to lunar calendar. Among the festivals, Gaan-ngai is the biggest and most colourful festival of the Rongmei who follow the indigenous religion known as Tingkao Ragwang Chaprtak (TRC); it prolongs for five to seven days. Each day of the festival has its own meaning and speciality. Gaan-ngai festival commences on the 13th day of Rongmei lunar month Gaan-ngaibu (December or January). In the festival they perform various rites and rituals like Guhcheng Phaimei (Ginger offering at the abode of village presiding various rites and rituals like Guhcheng Phaimei (Ginger offering at the abode of village presiding

deity), Guakpaijaomei (Observation of pig spleen at the courtyard of Khangchu), Khunnumei (offering at the village gate), Raang pammei (ritual of reaffirmation), Naapchanmei (calling of paddy), Mhailapmei (extraction of new fire), Raren Loumei, (worship of Seven Bothers Gods), Buhkaomei (calling of soul), Joupan Keimei (libation of wine) etc. for abundant harvest, wellbeing and general prosperity for the whole village community. They also bid ritual farewell to the dead ancestors by offering food and drinks on the graves. The cultural values, the aesthetic and creative senses, their love of beauty and colour are expressed in the festival through dance, colourful dresses and music. Different types of dances such as Tamchan Laam, (Tamchan dance), Laophun Laam (seed sowing dance), Laoreo Laam (weeding dance), Laotai Laam (dance of cutting of paddy plants), Laodi Laam (harvest dance), Gaa Laam (crab dance), Khoiguna Laam (bee mating dance), Kit Laam, (cricket dance), Raengdai Laam (dance of hornbill), Goichei Bang Laam (the dance of movement of the horn of the bull), Apang Laam (huluk (monkey) dance of plucking fruits), Tareng Laam (spinning dance) etc. are performed at the selected houses by the boys and girls of the dormitories with colourful traditional attire. These dances are known as Chapa Laam (festival dance). All the festival dances are accompanied by relevant songs and musicals instruments like drum, cymbals, gong etc. The young boys perform games and sports like Tao Phaimei (stone throwing), Daan Chammei (long jump), Nao Khemmei (wrestling) etc. at the Danshanpung (village jumping ground) in the present of the villagers to show their strength and ability. Various items of delicious food and drink are prepared and consumed. Jeigan Tumei (communal feast) at the Khangchu is tantamount to oath taking to stand as one in time of misery and happiness. Before meal they shout hoi invoking Tingkao Ragwang (the Almighty God). The whole culture, religion and social life are interwoven in the performance of Gaan-ngai. It is a festival for spreading good will, peace and prosperity and preservation of cultural identity.

15. CONTRIBUTION TO THE SOCIETY: The work contributes to some certain extent in the field of social relevance as Gaan-ngai festival serves as a reunion of family members, relatives, friends and love ones. By participating in the festival, people settle disputes and misunderstandings. Socially and culturally, Gaan-ngai promotes culture and traditions, peace and unity within the family system and the society as a whole.


